The Victorian 9 column is ideal for low drop windows where space is limited.








Burnishing is an alternative option to an all-over top coat paint finish for the Rococo design. First, the radiator is given a darker base coat, then a special burnishing paste is applied by hand to highlight the detailed scrollwork creating a stunning masterpiece.

We employ highly experienced specialists and use traditional application techniques in this process to achieve outstanding results.

The burnished finish is available in iron (silver), antique gold or copper.






